**Tour #1 - SOLD OUT** This is your one and only opportunity to see this collection of masterpieces at the debut of LOOKING EAST: How Japan inspired Monet, Van Gogh, and other Western artists. This exhibit explores the phenomenon that began in the mid-19th century when Japan opened its port to the international trade and a hunger for all things Japanese led to a significant shift in Western art. You will see masterpieces by Vincent Van Gogh, Mary Cassatt, Edgar Degas, Paul Gauguin and Claude Monet -- alongside rare works by influential Japanese artists





#### **Tour #2** - de Young Museum (Tuesday, April 5, 2016)

We will attend the annual Bouquets to Art, where art and nature come together in creative and multi-dimensional ways through the work of inspiring floral designers. We will also tour the Oscar de la Renta world premier retrospective featuring five decades of work organized into thematic sections, including Spanish, Russian and garden influences. A café is available on site and lunch is on your own.





# **Tour #3** - di Rosa Gallery and Artesa Tour and Wine Tasting, Napa (Thursday, May 26, 2016)

di Rosa gallery is considered the most significant holding of bay area art in the world, featuring over 2,000 works by 800 artists housed in 3 buildings, plus many selections of open-air art. We will also experience the art, wine and scenic views of Artesa estate where the "fusion of architecture, artistry and wine growing reaches soaring heights." Lunch, wine tasting and a tour of the grounds and art work are all included in this tour price.



**Tour #4** - UC-Berkeley Art Museum and Botanical Gardens (Thursday, July 21, 2016)

We will start our day walking through the beautiful and captivating UC Botanical Gardens, which has one of the most diverse plant collections in the USA. We then travel to the Berkeley Art Museum, now housed in a new building where we will take a guided tour of the Berkeley Eye Exhibition and explore the new building. Lunch will be on your own in one of the many local restaurants, or you can visit the Babette Café in the museum, featuring locally sourced food.
