TOUR #1 - THURSDAY APRIL 13, 2017

Oakwilde Ranch and Sculpture Park & Haggin Museum with lunch included

An "oasis of visual pleasure" years in the making but largely unknown has gone public in undulating Sierra foothills outside Valley Springs: **Oakwilde Ranch & Sculpture Park.**

Oakwilde is an open-air gallery. Big artworks range unexpectedly across the contours of cattle country - to the puzzlement of the cattle - sculptures in meadow, on hilltop and among blue oak.

Oakwilde is not so much a destination as a journey, a yearslong effort to sculpt not only large-format artworks but the land itself, the better to showcase big art.

On a guided tour, we will spend about one and a half hours exploring the 52 acre sculpture park in the rolling hills 30 miles above Stockton. Come prepared to walk around this

canvas of contemporary art and sculpture set in a spectacular nature park.

To facilitate ease of walking on the trails walking sticks and walking shoes are in order. **Lunch is included and will be served indoors on the property.** The menu will include meat or pesto ravioli, salad, wine and dessert. Gluten free options available if arranged 3 weeks prior to the trip.

Following lunch, we'll travel to the **Haggin Museum in Stockton.** The building will be under renovation at this time so we will be exploring the historical area of the museum on a guided tour covering both local and regional history of California.

Sunset Magazine has described this beautiful museum as, "one of the



undersung gems of California." This impressive brick building has stood in the center of Stockton's lush Victory Park for over 85 years, but it's what's on the inside that makes it worth visiting.

TOUR #2 - TUESDAY, MAY 16, 2017

Filoli with lunch included

Filoli is a country house set in 16 acres of formal gardens surrounded by a 654-acre estate built in 1915 by Mr. and Mrs. William Boum. The name of the estate is an acronym formed by combining the first two letters from the key words of William Bourn's credo: "FIght for a just cause; LOve your fellow man; LIve a good life."

Our visit will include a guided tour of the house, as well as a tour of the exquisite gardens.

We will also be served a box lunch on the grounds, and the price is included in the tour.





TOUR #3 - THURSDAY, JUNE 15, 2017

California Caverns Highway House Restaurant Amador County Museum with lunch included

We will drive to Mountain Ranch and visit a natural artistic wonder: California Cavern, and are scheduled to take a 60-80 minute walking tour of this State Historic Landmark cavern. This cave has a natural trail, mostly horizontal with a few stairs. The temperature is 55 degrees. If it should rain before our visit it may be slightly muddy, so dress casually and wear good walking shoes. This cavern was discovered in 1849 making it the State's first show cave. Visitors travel through numerous large, highly decorated chambers featuring stalactites, helictites and flowstones.

Lunch at the Highway House will be included in the price of the tour, and we will be served a variety of salads, sandwiches and/or quiche. Tea, lemonade, coffee and dessert will be provided. A no-host bar will be set up for our group.

Next, we are off to the Amador County Museum in Jackson. The museum is housed in a home built for Armstead Brown in 1859 and is currently furnished with items donated by residents in the area. You will see a diverse collection of furniture, clothes, instruments and tools of the time.

A second guided tour will be to the mining model exhibit, a replica of the Kennedy Mine, which will give a history and perspective of mining, from placer to deep rock methods.





TOUR #4 - SATURDAY, AUGUST 19, 2017

Palace of the Legion of Honor Presidio Officers' Club

We will travel to San Francisco to visit the Palace and have a guided tour of the special Degas exhibit, "Degas, Impressionism, and the Paris Millinery Trade".

Edgar Degas (1834-1917) was a French painter, sculptor and print artist; often associated with the subject of dance. In his words, "art is not what you see, but what you make others see."



During our visit you will have time to explore the museum's regular collections and have a *no-host lunch* at the museum restaurant.

We will then travel to the nearby Presidio Officers' Club, where we can experience 10,000 years of history with a distinctly West Coast perspective.



TOUR #5 - TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2017

Cornerstone Sonoma Old Town Sonoma

The Cornerstone facility in Sonoma has now become home to the Sunset Garden and Outdoor Test Kitchen.



We will enjoy a guided tour of the 25 or more gallery-style walk through gardens that are ever changing. We will then have time to visit the many boutique shops, galleries, café, wineries and tasting rooms.



The bus will take us to Old Town Sonoma where people can choose a restaurant for a *no-host lunch* and then visit the mission, shops and enjoy the local art.
