TOUR #2 – Saturday, March 24

San Jose Museum of Quilts and Textiles plus San Jose Museum of Art

We will begin our day at the Quilt and Textiles Museum that is somewhat small in size but packs a big punch. Founded in 1977, the museum is the first in the United States devoted solely to [quilts](#) and [textiles](#) as an art form. Holdings include a permanent collection of over 550 quilts, garments and ethnic textiles, emphasizing artists of the 20th- and 21st-century, and a research library with over 500 books concerning the history and techniques of the craft.



Artistic works featured are unique, often poignant and visually stunning.

If time permits, you may visit any of the free art galleries next to this museum.

At noon, the bus will take us to the nearby San Jose Museum of Art. We have a guided tour of the museum scheduled at 2pm. Lunch is on your own. There are several restaurants in the area such as San Jose Original Joes, Il Fornaio, McCormick & Schmick's as well as Café Too, a small café inside the museum.



Please wear comfortable walking shoes as you may have to walk several blocks to find the restaurant of your choice. We will provide a map of several of the downtown area restaurants.

TOUR #3 – Thursday, June 7
San Francisco Museum of Modern Art

Our visit includes a guided tour of the special exhibition: **Rene Magritte: The Fifth Season.** This exhibit, the first overview of Magritte's work on the West Coast in more than thirty years, explores the relationship between language and images; between words and objects and includes about 65 works. He was one of the most intriguing painters associated with Surrealism, but he did not fully find his voice until after breaking ties with the movement.

You will have lunch on your own and will also have additional time to explore the new and improved MOMA.
